

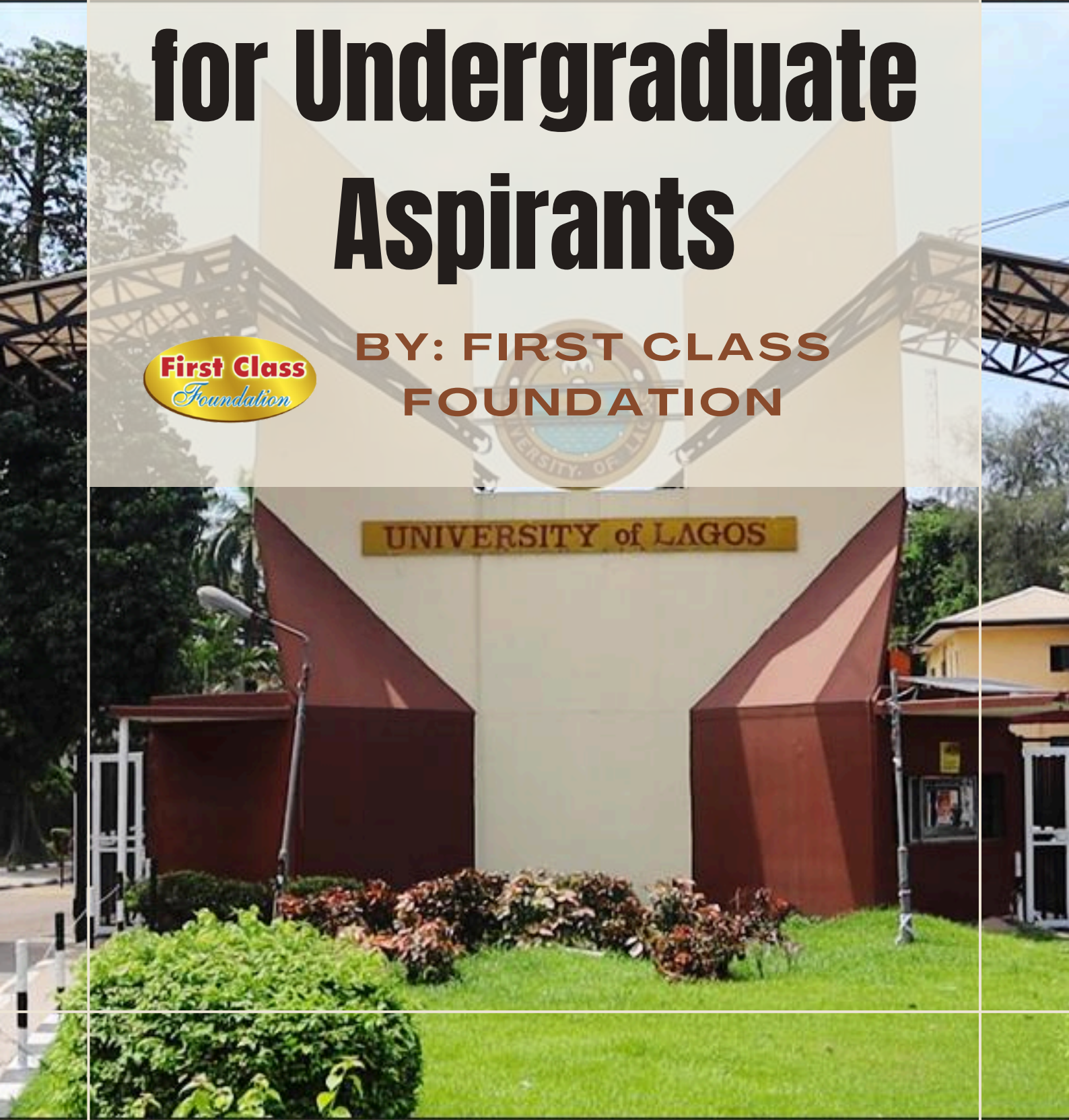

## Introduction

Welcome to the University of Lagos admission guide, compiled by the First Class Foundation (FCF) of the University of Lagos. This guide is designed for those who have chosen the University of Lagos as their first choice in the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) examination and are eager to gain admission into various undergraduate programs offered by the university.

## Admission Requirements

### General Requirements

To be eligible for admission into the University of Lagos, you must meet the following general requirements:

1. **Minimum Age:** You must be at least 16 years old by the 31st of October in the admission year.
2. **O'Level Results:**
  - A minimum of **five credit passes** in relevant subjects, including English Language and Mathematics, obtained in just one sitting in WASSCE/GCE/NECO/NABTEB.
  - Specific subject requirements for your chosen course can be found in the admission requirements PDF (Attached to this Admission guide folder).
3. **JAMB/UTME:**
  - You must have taken the JAMB/UTME examination and scored at least 200 for most courses (check specific course requirements for variations).
4. **Post-UTME:**
  - The University conducts a Post-UTME screening, and you must participate in this to be considered for admission.

### Faculty-Specific Requirements

Different faculties may have additional requirements or higher cut-off marks. It is crucial to check the specific requirements for your chosen course of study. The admission requirements pdf is attached to this Admission Guide folder.

# 2024/2025 Post-UTME and Screening Exercise Details

The University of Lagos online registration for the Post-UTME Screening Exercise for admission into **ALL UNDERGRADUATE COURSES/PROGRAMMES** for the 2024/2025 Academic Year will commence from **Monday, 5th August to Friday, 23rd August 2024**.

## Eligible Candidates

- **First Choice:** Candidates who made the University of Lagos their first choice in the 2024/2025 UTME and scored **200 and above** are eligible to apply for the Post-UTME Online Screening.
- **O'Level Requirements:** Candidates must possess **five (5) credit passes** at one sitting in relevant O/level subjects, including English Language and Mathematics.
- **JAMB CAPS:** Only candidates who have uploaded their O'Level results on the JAMB Central Admissions Processing System (CAPS) on or before **9th September 2024** will be considered for admission.
- **Age Requirement:** Candidates who will not be **sixteen (16) years** of age by 31st October 2024 are not eligible and need not apply.
- **Post-UTME Participation:** Candidates who do not participate in the Post-UTME Online Aptitude test will not be considered for admission.

## Additional Notes

- **Former Students:** Former students whose admissions were withdrawn due to poor academic performance or absence status may re-apply, provided the new admission is for a different program/course.
- **Expelled Students:** Any student expelled from the University cannot be offered fresh admission.
- **Screening Fee:** The screening fee is **₦2,000**.

## Registration Procedure

Eligible candidates should log on to the University of Lagos website [www.unilag.edu.ng](http://www.unilag.edu.ng) and follow these steps:

1. Click on **Admissions**.
2. Click on **Post-UTME Application**.

3. Login with UTME Application number as username and surname in lowercase as password.
4. Generate and print payment advice.
5. Proceed to any commercial bank to make payment or pay online.
6. Return to the University portal to complete the screening form.
7. Print Post-UTME Examination Pass.

### **Post-UTME Test (Online)**

- **Dates:** The Post-UTME Online Aptitude test will hold from **Monday, 2nd September to Friday, 6th September 2024.**
- **Format:** The test is a computer-based test (CBT) covering English Language, Mathematics, and General Paper.
- **Participation:** Only candidates who participate in the Post-UTME Online Aptitude test will be considered for admission.

Candidates are advised to adhere strictly to the guidelines and obtain necessary clarifications.

### **Important Note on Conduct**

The University of Lagos has a **zero tolerance for drug abuse**. The University shall withdraw the admission of newly admitted students who test positive for drug use whenever the University conducts the test, either before or after registration.

### **Steps to Calculate Potential Aggregate Score**

Before the admission process begins, it is crucial to calculate your potential aggregate score and compare it with the previous year's cut-off marks. This will give you an idea of your chances of getting admitted to your desired course. Here's how to calculate your aggregate score:

1. **JAMB Score (50%):** Divide your JAMB score by 8.
2. **O'Level Results (20%):** Use the points system:
  - A1 = 4.0
  - B2 = 3.6
  - B3 = 3.2
  - C4 = 2.8
  - C5 = 2.4
  - C6 = 2.0.
3. **Post-UTME Score (30%):** The Post-UTME score is calculated out of 30.
4. **Aggregate Score:** Sum the scores from the above components.

### Example Calculation

- **JAMB Score:** 240
  - $240/8 = 30$
- **O'Level Grades:** A1, B2, B3, C4, C5
  - Total Points =  $(4.0+3.6+3.2+2.8+2.4)=16$
- **Post-UTME Score:** 25 out of 30
- **Aggregate Score:**  $30+16+25=71$

Compare your calculated aggregate score with the previous year's cut-off marks (included in the admission guide folder) to evaluate your chances of admission. If your score is significantly lower than the required cut-off, consider applying for a different course before the admission process starts.

3. **How can I check my admission status?** Visit the JAMB CAPS portal and the University of Lagos website for updates.
